You will develop large scale community events that provide a profile with our local and external community partners as well as developing and maintaining effective working relationships with key staff at the University of Birmingham, the City Council, the Police and other internal and external stakeholders.

You will also develop core and student staff from the Community Warden Scheme ensuring the annual plan of work is professionally and successfully implemented.

We are looking for an individual who has demonstrable experience of working within a community based environment and knowledge and understanding of key policy areas relating to community work. You will have experience of working within and monitoring a budget along with experience of delivering large scale events with numerous stakeholders.
